Position Overview:

Assembly Technicians work in various locations and are responsible for the installation of mechanical, electrical and/or hydraulic components. Technicians read and interpret schematics and drawings to assemble proprietary presses, assembly line equipment, and conveyor machinery. This position is also required to assist with initial startup and any necessary troubleshooting of new and refurbished equipment. Assembly Technicians must be eager to learn, punctual and a team player; craftsmanship and personal pride in your work are of utmost importance.

Job Functions and Qualifications:

- Install mechanical, electrical, and/or hydraulic components.
- Read and interpret blueprints/schematics.
- Wire/plumb, operate, and troubleshoot electrical and/or hydraulic systems.
- Assist in other processes/tasks as required.
- Work as a team or independently to meet team goals.
- Motivated to learn and have a high standard of work.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Resourceful and creative problem solver.
- Provide your own tools.
- Other tasks as assigned/required.

Essential Functions:
