

## How to Make 2023 IRS Tax Payment, Extension Payments and 2024 Estimated Payments

### Pay from Your Bank Account

For individuals only. No registration required. No fees from IRS. Schedule payments up to a year in advance.

**Pay Now with Direct Pay**

### Pay by Debit Card, Credit Card or Digital Wallet (e.g., PayPal)

For individuals and businesses (not for payroll tax deposits). Processing fees apply.

**Pay Now by Card or Digital Wallet**

You will see a Screen that Looks like this.

If you want to pay with a bank account click on Bank Account (Direct Pay) – No Fees for this.

Option 1. (Select Balance Due if you are Paying Tax Due for your 2023 Tax Return), Then Select Apply Payment to Income Tax Form 1040, Then Select, Tax Period for Payment, Select Year, 2023

Option 2. (Select Estimated Tax if you are Paying Estimated Taxes for your 2024 Tax Year, Apply Payment To, 1040ES (for 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ), Tax Period for Payment (Select Year 2024)

Option 3. (Extension Payment, If you are making an Extension Payment for your 2023 Tax Return, Then Apply Payment to (4868 for 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ), Then Select, Tax Period for Payment 2023

It will then say

Option 1.) “You have chosen to make a Balance Due payment for your Income Tax - Form 1040 for Tax Year 2023. Is this correct?”

Option 2) “You have chosen to make an Estimated Tax payment for your 1040ES (for 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ) for Tax Year 2024. Is this correct?”

Option 3.) “Please Confirm you have chose to make an extension payment for 2023, is this correct?”

Click Continue.

**Please NOTE – VERY IMPORTANT- ALL PAYMENTS MUST BE MADE BY TAXPAYER ON YOUR TAX RETURN NOT THE SPOUSE OR THE PAYMENT WONT BE APPLIED CORRECTLY**

*Verify Identity (below - This is just for verifying identity not for payment information)*

You will need to have a prior year return to verify information. Recommend doing the prior year, example if you are making a payment for 2023, using 2022 tax return information. (unless your 2023 Return has already been filed)

Tax Verification Year: Select Verification Year

- Filing Status: From Tax Return (A single taxpayer)
- A married taxpayer and filed a joint return
- A married taxpayer and filed a separate return
- A head of household (you were unmarried on the last day of the year, you paid more than half the costs of keeping up a home for the year, and you had a qualifying person living in the home for more than half the year)
- A qualifying widow(er) with a dependent child (you were qualified to use this status for 2 years following the year your spouse died and had not remarried during this time)

Then click continue. Enter in your payment amount from your Form 1040-V Payment Voucher.

Confirm your Payment amount. Select your payment amount (it can be up to 365 days in advance).
