## How to Make 2023 Indiana Tax Payment, Extension Payments and 2024 Estimated Payments

(You can make a payment by logging into your INTIME account or you can make a payment without creating or logging into your INTIME Account) *If you do not setup an INTIME Account and make the payment that way it is imperative that you save the email and confirmation code that you used to make your payment if you want to change or adjust the payment that you are make or have previously made.*

Either login to your INTIME Account or Click make a payment.

To make an extension payment, tax return payment for 2023 or estimated tax payment (2024) click on Non-Bill payments.



If you want to pay with a bank account click on Bank Account – No Fees for this.

Options to Select

Select Individual

Enter in Primary Taxpayer Social Security Number. Then select payment type. Estimated Tax Payment (this would be for 2024 Tax Year, unless you are making your final payment for 2023 for the January 15, 2024 payment for 2023.)

(If you are logging in see directions below) – See Step 4 to Continue with the standard instructions for making a payment as they are the same whether logging in or not just be sure to save your confirmation code if you are NOT logged in).

1.) Login in with your username and password. You will likely need your code. However, you set it up. It will either go to your phone, email or app you setup the code to go to.

2.) The screen will look like this:

3.) Click on Make a Payment.



4. After You click Payment you will have the option to enter your banking information.



5. When it asks for the payment type (you can select estimated payment to pay your 2024 estimated tax payment or return payment to pay your 2023 Tax payment). Please note that the due date this year is April 15, 2024. Scheduling it after that will cause interest to accrue. Also DO NOT wait until the due date or the day or two before as the system often gets busy and it won't allow you to make the payment.
