Thus, you may be the subject of a "consumer report" and/or "investigative consumer report" as defined by the Fair Credit Reporting Act (15 U.S.C. § 1681). These reports may contain information about your character, general reputation, personal characteristics and mode of living, whichever are applicable. The reports may also contain information about you relating to your criminal history, social security verification, or other background checks. You have the right, upon written request made within a reasonable time after the receipt of this notice, to request disclosure of the nature and scope of any investigative consumer report prepared by contacting SCPC and First Advantage, P.O.
