Environmental Policy Statement

Portcrane.sg supplies wire rope, motors, drives, gearboxes, brakes, cables and associated engineering services to container terminals and port operators. We recognise that our activities — sourcing, logistics, delivery and on-site technical support — carry an environmental footprint, and that the equipment we specify directly influences the energy consumption and emissions of our customers' crane fleets. This policy sets out how we manage both.

1. Scope

This policy applies to all Portcrane.sg activities, personnel and appointed representatives, including procurement, warehousing, freight forwarding, and attendance at customer terminals and third-party workshops in Singapore and the wider Asia-Pacific region.

2. Commitments

Portcrane.sg commits to:

- **Comply with applicable legislation**, including the Environmental Protection and Management Act, the Environmental Public Health Act, and the requirements of the National Environment Agency, together with the environmental rules of every terminal at which we work.
- **Prevent pollution** arising from the handling, storage and transport of lubricants, greases, preservative coatings and rope dressings, and ensure that spill containment and correct disposal routes are in place wherever such materials are present.
- **Promote energy-efficient equipment** in our technical recommendations — IE3 and higher-efficiency motors, variable frequency drives, regenerative braking and electrified RTG/RMG conversions — so that customers reduce diesel consumption and emissions across the crane fleet.
- **Reduce waste and packaging** by consolidating shipments, reusing rope reels and transport cradles where condition permits, and specifying recyclable or reduced packaging with our supply partners.
- **Route end-of-life material responsibly**, directing discarded wire rope, scrap steel, copper cable and used electrical components to licensed recyclers rather than general waste.
- **Minimise freight impact** by preferring sea freight over air freight where lead time allows, and by consolidating orders into fewer, fuller consignments.
- **Select responsible supply partners**, giving preference to manufacturers operating certified environmental management systems and able to provide material and substance declarations on request.

- **Pursue continual improvement** by reviewing this policy and our environmental performance at least annually, and by acting on findings raised by customers, authorities or our own personnel.

3. Responsibility

The Director holds overall responsibility for this policy and for providing the resources needed to implement it. All personnel and appointed representatives are responsible for working in accordance with it and for reporting environmental incidents, near-misses or opportunities for improvement without delay.

4. Communication and review

This policy is communicated to all personnel, is made available to customers, supply partners and other interested parties on request, and is published on our website. It is reviewed annually or sooner where there is a material change to our activities or to applicable legal requirements.

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Occupational Health & Safety Policy Statement

Our personnel work in and around live container terminals: at height on crane structures, near lifting operations, alongside container handling equipment, and on medium-voltage electrical systems. Portcrane.sg treats the health and safety of its people, its customers' people and the public as a condition of doing business, not as a trade-off against schedule or cost.

1. Scope

This policy applies to all Portcrane.sg personnel, appointed representatives and subcontractors, in our own premises and at every customer site, terminal, vessel, workshop or storage facility we attend.

2. Commitments

Portcrane.sg commits to:

- **Comply with the Workplace Safety and Health Act and its subsidiary regulations**, including the Workplace Safety and Health (Risk Management) Regulations, together with Ministry of Manpower requirements, Maritime and Port Authority rules and the site-specific safety requirements of each terminal operator.
- **Follow the host operator's system without exception.** Where we work on a customer's site, that operator's permit-to-work, induction, lockout/tagout, working-at-height and lifting procedures take precedence, and our personnel will not commence work until those requirements are met.
- **Carry out risk assessment before work begins**, identifying hazards, evaluating risk and applying controls in order of the hierarchy — elimination and substitution first, engineering and administrative controls next, personal protective equipment last.
- **Control the high-risk activities inherent to our work:** working at height on crane booms, machinery houses and trolleys; lifting and rigging operations; work on and near energised medium- and low-voltage systems; stored-energy hazards in brakes, springs and reeving systems; confined spaces; and hot work.
- **Deploy only competent personnel**, verified as trained, medically fit and holding the certification required for the task and the site, and provide the correct personal protective equipment at no cost to the individual.
- **Uphold stop-work authority.** Any person acting for Portcrane.sg may stop work they believe to be unsafe, and will face no adverse consequence for doing so.
- **Report and investigate** all incidents, injuries, dangerous occurrences and near-misses; notify them to the customer and to the authorities where required; and act on the root causes identified.

- **Manage subcontractors and supply partners** to the same standard we apply to ourselves, assessing their safety capability before appointment.
- **Support the health and wellbeing of our people**, including management of fatigue, heat stress and manual handling risk in tropical outdoor working conditions.
- **Consult our personnel** on matters affecting their safety, and pursue continual improvement through annual review of this policy and our safety performance.

3. Responsibility

The Director holds overall accountability for occupational health and safety and for providing the resources, training and time required to work safely. Every person acting for Portcrane.sg is responsible for their own safety and for the safety of those affected by their work.

4. Communication and review

This policy is issued to all personnel and subcontractors, provided to customers on request, and reviewed at least annually or following any significant incident or change in our activities.

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EHS Management Commitment & Self-Declaration

This declaration describes how Portcrane.sg manages environmental, health and safety matters in practice, and states plainly the current certification position of the company. It is intended to accompany the Environmental Policy (PC-EHS-01) and the Occupational Health & Safety Policy (PC-EHS-02) in vendor registration and tender submissions.

1. Certification status

Portcrane.sg is not currently certified to ISO 14001:2015 or ISO 45001:2018. Our management arrangements are structured on the principles of those standards — leadership commitment, hazard and aspect identification, risk-based controls, competence, operational control, incident reporting and management review — but no accredited certification body has audited or certified the company against them, and we make no claim to certified status. Where a customer requires certified status as a condition of award, we will state that requirement is not met rather than represent otherwise.

Products supplied by Portcrane.sg are sourced from established European and Asian manufacturers, many of whom hold ISO 9001, ISO 14001 and ISO 45001 certification in their own right. Manufacturer certificates, declarations of conformity, test certificates and material certificates are supplied with the goods or on request.

2. How we manage EHS in practice

- **Leadership.** The Director approves EHS policy, allocates resources, and reviews performance at least annually.
- **Risk and aspects.** Hazards and environmental aspects are identified for each type of work we undertake, and reassessed before any site attendance.
- **Legal register.** Applicable Singapore legislation and terminal-specific requirements are identified and monitored for change.
- **Site work.** All site activity is performed under the host operator's permit-to-work and induction regime; a job-specific risk assessment and method statement is prepared where required by the customer.
- **Competence.** Personnel and subcontractors are verified as trained and certified for the tasks assigned, and records are retained.

- **Supply chain.** Supply partners are assessed on quality, EHS capability and their ability to provide documentation on materials and substances.
- **Incidents.** Incidents, dangerous occurrences and near-misses are recorded, reported to the customer and the authorities as required, investigated for root cause, and closed out with corrective action.
- **Documentation.** Policies, risk assessments, competence records and incident records are maintained and made available to customers on request.

3. Insurance and statutory standing

Portcrane.sg is registered with the Accounting and Corporate Regulatory Authority of Singapore and maintains the insurance cover appropriate to its activities. Certificates of currency, business profile and any further statutory documentation are provided on request as part of vendor registration.

4. Declaration

I confirm that the statements made in this document and in the accompanying policy statements are accurate to the best of my knowledge, that they represent the actual practice of the company, and that Portcrane.sg will notify any customer relying on this declaration of any material change to the position described.
