

Meet our Chief Guest: Sh. Ashish Butail

It is with great pleasure that we welcome Sh. Ashish Butail, Member of Legislative Assembly a dynamic leader, dedicated public servant, and former Hon'ble Chief Parliamentary Secretary of Himachal Pradesh, as our distinguished Chief Guest.

Sh. Ashish Butail was born on January 9, 1980, into a family renowned for its deep-rooted legacy in public service, business, and philanthropy. He is a son of Smt. Beena Butail and Sh. Brij Behari Lal Butail, a veteran statesman who has served the people of Himachal Pradesh with distinction as both the Hon'ble Speaker of the H.P. Vidhan Sabha and as a Cabinet Minister.

His family's commitment to society traces back generations. His grandfather, Lala Bansi Lal Butail, and great-grandfather, Lala Kanhaiya Lal Butail, were prominent merchants and philanthropists from Pragpur who were also actively involved in the Indian independence movement, instilling in him values of leadership and service from an early age.

Sh. Butail received his early education at the prestigious Bishop Cotton School, Shimla, an institution known for building character and excellence. He then pursued his graduation, earning a Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com) degree from the Symbiosis College of Arts & Commerce, Pune.

A multifaceted personality, he is a successful tea planter and entrepreneur before dedicating his life fully to politics and public service, bringing a practical and business-acumen approach to governance. Sh. Ashish Butail's political career began with the Indian Youth Congress, where his leadership qualities were quickly recognized. His rise through the ranks of the Indian National Congress is a testament to his dedication and connect with the people: In 2011-2013 he was first elected President of the Lok Sabha Youth Congress Committee, Kangra (H.P.). In 2014 got appointed as Secretary of the Himachal Pradesh Congress Committee (HPCC), subsequently served as the Treasurer of the HPCC. And currently holds the pivotal position of General Secretary of the Himachal Pradesh Congress Committee.

Sh. Butail's popular mandate was first established when he won his maiden election in December 2017, representing the Palampur constituency in the 13th H.P. Vidhan Sabha. As a legislator, he contributed significantly as a member of the Estimates Committee and the Rural Planning Committee.

His service was reaffirmed by the people of Palampur when he was re-elected to the State Legislative Assembly in December 2022. In recognition of his capabilities and dedication, he was appointed as the Chief Parliamentary Secretary on January 8, 2023. In this crucial role, he is attached to the Chief Minister and the Education Minister, overseeing key departments such as Urban Development, Elementary Education, and Higher Education. Driven by a vision to revolutionize the state's educational framework, Sh. Butail undertook a dedicated study tour to Singapore, a global leader in education. His mission was to research and understand their best practices, innovative teaching methodologies, and cutting-edge administrative systems. The insights gained from this visit are now being actively studied for implementation, aiming to incorporate breakthrough policies to enhance the quality and accessibility of education in Himachal Pradesh.

Despite his numerous responsibilities and accomplishments, Sh. Ashish Butail remains a soft-spoken and easily accessible representative, known for his unwavering commitment to his constituents. He has a special interest in social work, consistently striving for the welfare and development of society. An avid reader, he finds his favourite pastime in books, which reflects his thoughtful and informed approach to policy and governance.

On the personal front, he is happily married to Smt. Kanika Bhullar, and the couple is blessed with a daughter Anayita.

A Legacy of Leadership: The Stewards of Our Club



In the year 1978, twenty-eight service minded citizens of Palampur joined hands to serve and alleviate the sufferings of the fellow huma beings and formed Rotary Club with Dr. Shiv Kumar as its Chartered President and Er. Kuldeep Sood as Charter Secretary. The club members decided to adopt Leprosy Home in village Chowki and render Free Vaccination, Health Care and Environment Protection Programme. Since then quite a few permanent service projects have been taken up which are serving the community to the best satisfaction of all.In 1991, the Palampur Rotary Helpage Foundation with its members drawn from amongst Rotary, and the local community was got registered. The Foundation decided to create facilities for the dignified stay of Senior Citizens and also for the care, stay and education of parentless children and for this purpose Late. S.K. Bhardwaj Founder Sr. Vice Chairman of the Foundation generously donated land in Saliana.

Apna Ghar-Home of Senior Citizens

Deeply concerned with the situations The Palampur Rotary Helpage foundation accepted the challenge to create infrastructure for the dignified stay of Senior Citizens, who had the feeling unwanted in their families and also facilities for the care, stay and education of unfortunate children who had lost their children. With the support of the community, the task of establishing Home for the Senior Citizen and Home for the parentless children was taken up. Apna Ghar was completed and dedicated on 08-10-1994 by PRIP Rtn. Rajinder K Saboo. Presently nine senior citizens are residing in the Apna Ghar and available on self-supporting self-financing basis for the rest of their life.


