Following the guidance of the City of San Francisco, Beacon Physical Therapy requires that you show proof that you have been vaccinated against COVID-19 prior to the course. You will still need to wear a mask, even if you are vaccinated. You cannot use a self-attestation of vaccination or a negative COVID-19 test. You must have proof that you are vaccinated. "Full Vaccination" means two weeks after your final dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. You can show your Vaccination Record Card (CRC) from the CDC. Or you can show an image of the card if you have a picture on your phone. Or you can use a digital COVID-19 vaccine record issued by the State of California: <https://myvaccinerecord.cdph.ca.gov/>

Under the health order, you may be exempt from the vaccination requirement if you have a qualifying medical condition. A list of recognized conditions that prevent someone from receiving the COVID-19 vaccine is available here: https://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/covid-19/clinical-considerations/covid-19-vaccines-us.html?CDC_AA_refVal=https://www.cdc.gov/vaccines/covid-19/info-by-product/clinical-considerations.html#Contraindications. In this case, you must provide evidence such as a letter from your doctor demonstrating your ineligibility for the vaccine *and* a negative COVID-19 test result taken within 3 days of the course start date.

Proof of vaccination can be shown directly to the course host (Beacon PT staff/Charles King) at the start of the first day of course, or if you prefer you may send it ahead of time via email to charles@beaconpt.com or fax it to 415-757-0874. If you are ineligible for the vaccine, please provide the evidence of ineligibility at least 1 week prior to the course and have your negative test results available at the start of the first day of the course.
