



Password jargon

- **Password** – A secret word or mix of letters, numbers, and symbols (like H@ppy2025?!) that you type to log in.
- **Passphrase** – A longer phrase made of real words (like Sunny garden with blue birds). Easier to remember, harder to guess.
- **PIN** – A short number code (like 1234 or 778899) used on phones or bank cards.
- **Passkey** – A new, safer way to log in using your fingerprint, face, or a device instead of typing a password.
