



Password jargon

- **Password** – A secret word or mix of letters, numbers, and symbols (like H@ppy2025?!) that you type to log in.
- **Passphrase** – A longer phrase made of real words (like Sunny_garden?blue bird). Easier to remember, harder to guess.
- **PIN** – (Personal Identification Number) A short number (4-8 digits) used at ATMS and to open a phone
- **Passkey** – A new, safer way to log in using your fingerprint, face, or a device instead of a password.
