### **Care and Cleaning Guide**

Always test cleaners on a small, inconspicuous area before cleaning entire surface.

#### **Cabinets**

No matter how careful a person may be with cabinets, normal wear and tear from everyday use will occur. Proper cleaning and maintenance, along with touching up scratches or chips will help keep the cabinets looking new.

The cabinets have a UV cured, water-based finish for long lasting durability and beauty. This environmentally friendly process helps protect against normal everyday use, but general upkeep and maintenance are extremely important. When cleaning, only use clean, soft, lint-free cloths on the cabinets.

#### Cleaning:

- Wipe down cabinets with a soft, damp cloth to remove dust and other particles, and then dry immediately with a different clean, soft cloth
- To remove buildup of grease and dirt, add a small amount of dish detergent (Dawn works best) to warm water. Dampen cloth
  with this solution and wipe down cabinetry. Remove all soap residue from surface with a damp cloth and then use a different
  soft, dry cloth to remove all dampness.
- Be sure to clean up spills immediately with a clean, soft cloth. Prolonged exposure to spills from food, water, oil or grease, along
  with other liquids will cause permanent damage or discoloration to the cabinet finish.

#### Scratches and Chips:

It is recommended to order a touch up kit with each order. The kit will contain a touch up marker and putty stick; these are used
to fix any scratches and chips in the cabinets. The touch up marker is used to hide any shallow scratches, while the putty stick
is used for deeper scratches or chips.

#### Hardware Adjustments:

Over time, door and drawer faces may become uneven or loose. This means the hardware will need to be adjusted or tightened.
 Each piece is adjustable by a set screw on the piece of hardware itself.

#### Things to Avoid:

- Do not wipe your cabinets with a dishcloth. They can contain soap, grease and other soil that can harm the finish on the cabinets.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, bleach, abrasive cleaners, ammonia, solvents, detergents, strong soap, furniture polish or waxes on the cabinets. The use of these products will affect the appearance and durability of the topcoat, causing the warranty to be void.
- Avoid dampness of cabinets. If water dampness is left on the cabinets, over time it will cause finish damage, later affecting the underlying wood.

### **Warranty Information**

#### **General Warranty Guidelines**

Maple Mill Cabinetry will, at its discretion, repair or replace any product we sell where our inspection reveals a defect in workmanship or materials for a period of one year after the original purchase. In no event shall Maple Mill Cabinetry be liable for consequential, indirect or incidental damages resulting from the installation, use or failure of its products. This warranty does not cover the labor costs regarding removal, return, re-installation, subsequent damage, and is not responsible for other materials used in the installation; regardless of whether the work was performed by a contractor, service company or the consumer. This warranty is the exclusive warranty of Maple Mill Cabinetry and is in lieu of all other warranties, expressed or implied.

#### WHAT IS EXCLUDED:

This warranty does not cover damage arising from any of the following:

- 1. Accidents or abuse
- 2. Mishandling or misuse
- 3. Improper storage or installation
- 4. Improper maintenance or repair
- 5. Any product changed or modified from its original status
- 6. Exposure to extreme temperatures or moisture levels (including water damage)
  - \* This warranty is not valid for products used for any purpose other than the purpose for which they were originally intended.

#### **Cabinets**

One Year Limited Warranty on Cabinets: Maple Mill Cabinetry warrants, to original consumer purchaser, for a period of one year from the original date of purchase, that all other components of the cabinets shall be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use

Over time, wood species in all finishes will exhibit color changes when exposed to different types of light and environments; it is a characteristic of stained and painted wood finishes to age over time when exposed to smoke, sunlight or general household cleaning chemicals. Due to the natural variation and aging process, differences may be observed in color match when replacing doors or adding cabinets at a later date. Such color changes are to be expected and are not considered a manufacturer defect and will not be considered for warranty replacement.

Graining differences, mineral streaks, and wood color variations are expected in wood cabinets and are not classified as defects and will not be considered for warranty replacement.

Painted finishes are exceedingly different from the standard stained finish. Since normal movement is typical in wood products, certain climatic conditions can cause finish breaks, recesses, and joint and panel lines which become more visible on painted product. Consequently, in places and environments of extremely high or extremely low humidity, painted finishes are not recommended. Expansion and contraction in doors and face frames can cause visible lines at the joints. The finish will still protect the surface and the structural integrity of the joint will not be affected. An open joint line is not considered a manufacturer defect and will not be considered for warranty replacement.

Lifetime Limited Warranty on Drawer Glides and Hinges: Maple Mill Cabinetry warrants to the original consumer purchaser, that the drawer glides and hinges used in the manufacturing of the cabinets shall be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use.

To process a warranty claim, contact the Maple Mill Cabinetry customer service department. Claims are to be submitted in writing with supporting pictures, along with a dated sales receipt as proof of purchase for a warranty claim to <a href="mailto:customerservice@maplemillcabintry.com">customerservice@maplemillcabintry.com</a>. If needed, inspection of the product may be requested by Maple Mill Cabinetry.

#### **Order Procedures:**

- All orders are to be submitted via email to the order processing department at <a href="mailto:customerservice@maplemillcabinetry.com">customerservice@maplemillcabinetry.com</a>
- A purchase order number (PO#) or job name is required before any order will be acknowledged or processed.
- If there is any missing information, a customer service representative will reach out to get any needed information and then process your order. The order will be on hold until all details are received.

#### **Order Changes, Cancellations & Returns:**

- Changes to cabinet orders must be made within 48 hours of order confirmation. Once the order is in production no changes can be made
- · Returns are not accepted as cabinets are made to order.

#### Freight, Delivery and Handling:

- Orders placed with Maple Mill Cabinetry will be delivered tailgate only via company delivery vehicle.
  - LTL orders are TBD for the delivery charge.
    - If a delivery is not accepted, a \$100 undeliverable load fee will be added to the invoice.

#### \* Tailgate Delivery - Driver brings product to the back/tailgate of the truck. Customer is responsible to unload product.

- All product labels are on the front of the product in the top right corner.
- To ensure safety in transportation and storage, do not face label down or stack larger, heavier items on top.
- · Do not lift boxes by the strapping. They can break or put pressure on the product, which can cause damage.
- Do not tip product onto corners to slide, move or pick up and do not set product down on corners. Everything needs to be picked up and set down flat to ensure no damage to the corners.

#### Payment Requirements and Process (Cash, Check or Credit Card):

- · Dealers are Net 30
- Credit and Term Policy:
  - \* A credit application must be submitted to establish payment terms with Maple Mill Cabinetry. Account terms will be Net 30 and the credit limit will be determined by credit history. Any account past due will be subject to a monthly 2% fee of the balance due and is charged monthly until the balance is paid in full. Maple Mill Cabinetry has the right to send any outstanding bills to collections if not in good standing.

Orders will not be processed or delivered if the account is not in good standing.

#### **Backordered Items:**

• Backordered items will ship freight prepaid and you will not incur added shipping charges.

#### **Damaged, Defective or Shortage:**

Customer must inspect delivered order in full and document missing or damaged items prior to contacting customer service.

All replacement orders must be submitted completely on the first request.

- If the item(s) purchased become damaged during shipping, the delivery driver will make note on the packing slip and inform the office. Customer service will reach out to you with a delivery date for the replacement product.
- All concealed (non-visible) damages need to be reported within five business days of delivery and a replacement will be shipped
  at no charge. If the customer does not report the damage within five business days of delivery, it is the responsibility of the
  customer to purchase the new item plus shipping cost.
- For replacement requests due to defects, the customer must send the original PO information and pictures, along with the requested replacement parts to <a href="mailto:customerservice@maplemillcabinetry.com">customerservice@maplemillcabinetry.com</a>
- Any product identified and verified as a shortage will be shipped at no charge. Shortage claims for missing product must be
  made within three business days of delivery. If the customer does not report the shortage within three business days of delivery,
  it will be the responsibility of the customer to purchase the new item plus shipping cost.

#### **Customer Installation Responsibility:**

- Cabinet doors and drawers are shipped without being straight and level. Doors and drawers are to be removed prior to cabinet
  installation and then re-installed and leveled once secured to the wall. If hardware is being used, always adjust prior to drilling.
  Over time, hinges on doors will need to be adjusted from cabinet use.
- All cabinets must be installed plumb, level and secured to each other. Improper installation will cause issues with cabinet
  performance and stability.
- Scratches, minor chips, and all nail holes are to be touched up with the touch up kit.
- Laminate countertops are made straight and may need to be scribed on site to fit during installation.

#### **Privacy**

All contact information given to Maple Mill Cabinetry will be used for the completion of that order. We do not share this information with outside parties.

### **Wood Product and Finish Information**

The real attraction of wood comes from the true natural qualities of wood itself which will vary in color, shades and grain. These characteristics are what make wood beautiful and distinct in color. All of our doors, drawers and face frames are made from solid maple.

Maple is a close-grained hardwood that is predominately white to creamy-white in color, with the occasional reddish-brown tones. Maple is characterized by its smooth, even grain pattern. Mineral streaks and tiny bird pecks are common and will appear darker when stained; these are not considered defects.

#### **Expansion and Contraction**

Solid wood naturally expands and contracts with normal humidity changes due to interior heating and cooling. As a result of this wood movement, slight separation may occur causing small "cracks" in the joints of doors, drawer fronts, face frames and on flat surfaces. These joint separations are unavoidable and should not be considered for warranty replacement (The joint separations are more noticeable on painted products due to the shadow line created from the separation).

When the cabinets are in a warm, moist environment (high humidity) the wood expands. In a dry, cooler environment (low humidity) the wood will contract. This affects the door frame, along with the door center panel as the season temperature and humidity levels change.

The contraction of the door center panel during low humidity may create the appearance of an unfinished line around the edge of the door panel. This is not considered a defect and a replacement door will not be issued. Touch up kits are available for incidentals such as this

#### **Finishes**

Over time, wood will age, and you will see a difference in color shade. Different environment factors such as the amount of natural light, grease, smoke or cleaners will affect the aging process. These color changes are natural to wood and are not defects. Due to this natural change, any replacement doors, drawers or added cabinets may not match.
