Introducing Brindabella Roses™, a collection of tough shrub roses selected for superior garden performance and show stopping flowers: bushy growth habits, *excellent* disease resistance, and fragrant doubled flowers in an array of traditional and modern colors. These low maintenance roses are very vigorous yet grow to only 4 feet tall and wide in 2 years' time. Very well suited to home gardens and commercial landscapes alike, the foliage is among the cleanest to be found in any shrub rose and the fragrance will stop any passerby in their tracks. ## Brindabella Glow™

*Rosa hybrid 'GRAapr'*

**Habit:** Freely branching with dense foliage and an upright to semi-weeping habit.

**Size:** Approximately 4 ft. tall and 4 ft. wide after 2 years.

**Flowers:** Corymbs bear 4 to 7 double-type flowers with a strong citrus-like fragrance. Flowers are apricot with light pink intonations at the marginal zone and soft yellow intonations towards the base. Flowers are approximately 7 cm in diameter.

## Brindabella Fresh Powder™

*Rosa hybrid 'GRAaus'*

**Habit:** Freely branching with dense foliage and an upright to semi-weeping habit.

**Size:** Approximately 4 ft. tall and 4 ft. wide after 2 years.

**Flowers:** Corymbs bear 2 to 4 double-type flowers with a moderate rose fragrance. Flowers are white flowers with pale pink intonations as flowers fade. Flowers are approximately 6 cm in diameter.

## Brindabella First Lady™


*Rosa hybrid 'GRAdkpk'*

**Habit:** Freely branching with dense foliage and an upright to semi-weeping habit.

**Size:** Approximately 4 ft. tall and 4 ft. wide after 2 years.

**Flowers:** Corymbs bear 2 to 6 double-type flowers with a strong rose fragrance. Flowers are lavender pink and fade to mauve pink. Flowers are approximately 8 cm in diameter.

## Brindabella Purple Prince™


*Rosa hybrid 'GRAppl'*

**Habit:** Freely branching with dense foliage and an upright habit.

**Size:** Approximately 4 ft. tall and 4 ft. wide after 2 years.

**Flowers:** Corymbs bear 4 to 7 double-type flowers with a strong rose fragrance. Flowers are light pink and fade to near-white. Flowers are approximately 6 cm.

## Brindabella Red Empress™

*Rosa hybrid 'GRAred'*

**Habit:** Freely branching with dense foliage and an upright to semi-weeping habit.

**Size:** Approximately 4 ft. tall and 4 ft. wide after 2 years.

**Flowers:** Solitary double-type flowers with a strong rose fragrance. Flowers are red-purple. Flowers are approx. 6 cm in diameter.

## Brindabella Dawn™

*Rosa hybrid 'GRAsalm'*

**Habit:** Freely branching with dense foliage and an upright to semi-weeping habit.

**Size:** Approximately 4 ft. tall and 4 ft. wide after 2 years.

**Flowers:** Corymbs bear 1 to 6 double-type flowers with a strong rose fragrance. Flowers are salmon colored, with tinges of apricot in hot weather. Flowers are approx. 8 to 10 cm in diameter.

## Brindabella Touch of Pink™

*Rosa hybrid 'GRAsuper'*

**Habit:** Freely branching with dense foliage and an upright to semi-weeping habit.

**Size:** Approximately 4 ft. tall and 4 ft. wide after 2 years.

**Flowers:** Corymbs bear 4 to 7 double-type flowers with a strong rose fragrance. Flowers are light pink and fade to near-white. Flowers are approximately 6 cm.
