- First Five-Year Plan (1951-1956)
- **Agricultural Development**: Focused on agriculture, irrigation, and energy to address food shortages. Projects like the Bhakra Nangal Dam were initiated.
- **Community Development**: Introduced community development programs to boost rural development.
- **Economic Growth:** Achieved a growth rate of 3.6%, exceeding the target • of 2.1%.
- Second Five-Year Plan (1956-1961)
- **Industrialization**: Focused on rapid industrialization, especially heavy industries like steel and iron (e.g., Bhilai and Rourkela steel plants).
- Socialist Pattern of Society: Emphasized reducing income inequality and * moving towards a socialist economic model.
- **Growth Target:** Targeted 4.5% GDP growth but achieved 4.3%. *
- Third Five-Year Plan (1961-1966)
- Self-Reliance: Aimed at making India self-sufficient in food grains * through increased agricultural production.
- **Defense and Development**: Increased defense expenditure after the 1962 * India-China War, affecting economic growth.
- **Growth Target:** Targeted 5.6% growth but achieved only 2.4% due to • challenges like wars and droughts.
