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- First Five-Year Plan (1951-1956)
- **Agricultural Development**: Focused on agriculture, irrigation, and energy to address food shortages. Projects like the Bhakra Nangal Dam were initiated.
- **Community Development**: Introduced community development programs to boost rural development.
- **Economic Growth:** Achieved a growth rate of 3.6%, exceeding the target • of 2.1%.
- Second Five-Year Plan (1956-1961)
- **Industrialization**: Focused on rapid industrialization, especially heavy • industries like steel and iron (e.g., Bhilai and Rourkela steel plants).
- Socialist Pattern of Society: Emphasized reducing income inequality and * moving towards a socialist economic model.


