

"The group will explore each art discipline in response to Liverpool as a city. In Art, you can explore a number of techniques for creating paintings/prints that can be applied when interacting with the city. In Music, we have looked at capturing urban soundscapes and using the recordings to inspire compositions. In Dance, we often consider the body in space and urban psychogeography, considering its influence on the movement of people in the city. With Film/Photography, we often examine an established portfolio of work by a selected artist, study their style and then reproduce it through our own practical application in the city of Liverpool" – Dr Malone. *This program is accredited.

PAYMENTS & DEADLINES

FEES:

- A Non Refundable Registration and Administration fee of \$100 must be paid to Live and Learn Centre, 159 The Chase, by Tuesday the 25th November 2025.
- A Non Refundable <u>Visa Processing Fee</u> of \$120 is to be paid to <u>Premier</u>
 Travel by <u>Friday the 28th November 2025.</u>
- Flight tickets: Starting from +/- USD \$1500 to be paid directly to Premier
 Travel after visas have been obtained. Provisional flight itineraries will be
 provided by Premier Travel for visa purposes. The exact payment deadline
 for flights will be communicated to you via our WhatsApp Group Chat.
 Please note that if we do a group rate or booking, the purchasing of
 individual tickets shall not be permitted. Once group flights are paid for,
 there will be no refund.
- Course Fees: For a group of 10: £2,084; For a group of 15: £1,999.
- Course fees include: Accommodation, Lectures, some meals and some accompanied excursions.
- Course fees DO NOT include: Local bus costs, evening meals, flights, spending money, unaccompanied excursions, VISA costs, airport transport.
- *25% of the course fees to be paid directly to Liverpool Hope University, the hosting institution, via their online platform by <u>January 31st 2026</u>.
- Full course fees are to be paid no later than the 16"H March 2026. These shall be paid directly to Liverpool Hope University, the hosting institution, via their online platform. The link and payment instructions shall be communicated to you in due course.

VISA processing and Administration (including document processing and gathering) will be handled by professional travel agents from Premier Travel as opposed to Live and Learn Student Centre. However, a letter of invitation for 'Proof of Accommodation' shall be supplied by the University. You can find a 'Visa Checklist' in our Registration Package.

*Kindly note that Live and Learn cannot be held responsible in the event of a visa denial as entry into the UK is solely determined by their Immigration department.
