

Winter on the Wharf Scarf
Any Gilded Age double skein
(sample done in Thames Street)
Gilded Garland - optional embellishment
US 15 long circular (we used 29")

Scarf is worked holding your sparkle yarn double stranded and your textured yarn held double stranded (working from center tail and tail from outside of your wound cake held together) then holding these 2 double stranded yarns of both yarns together making your working yarn 4 strands.

Cast on 3 stitches.

Knit 3 stitches then add 3 stitches using knitted cast on. Knit 6 stitches. Turn.
Add 3 (9 stitches)

Knit 3, purl 3, knit 3. Turn. Add 3 using knitted cast on (12 stitches).
Knit across row. Turn. Add 3 stitches using knitted cast on. (15 stitches).

Knit 3, purl 9, knit 3. Turn. Add 3 stitches using knitted cast on. (18 stitches).
Knit across row until 75 stitches.

Add 35 stitches using knitted cast on. Knit across to other end and add 36 stitches to other side of scarf. (145 stitches). Continue for 3 1/2" bind off very loosely.

Optional Gilded Garland add on. After adding 35/36 stitches to each end of scarf, Knit 2 rows. Cut yarn. Add garland and knit back and forth across scarf. Cut garland. Knit 2 rows with your 4 strands of Gilded Age yarns. Cut yarn. Knit 1 row with garland in knit 1 slip 1. Knit across with 4 strands of Gilded Age double skein. Knit 2 rows. Cut yarn and use garland to knit 1 slip 1 across entire length of scarf. Cut yarn. Knit 1 row with Gilded Age double skein (4 strands). Bind off very loosely.
