

# Newport Yarn and fibers

## Snood



**Yarn:** Newport Yarn and fibers-Ocean Drive, Thames Street, or Bellevue Ave.

**Color:** Rough Point

**Needle size:** US9, US10, or US11 24" cable

**Notions:** 2 st markers, tapestry needle

**Experience Level:** Beginner

**Gauge:** This snood is a one size fits all.

**Finished Measurements:** Neck 32", Bottom 42" Length 18".

### Pattern:

-Holding two strands together, cast on 120(116, or 92) sts. Place your 1st stitch marker and join to work in the round.

-Work in 1X1 rib for 6 rounds.

-Beginning at the first stitch marker, knit 59(57, or 45)stitches and place your 2nd stitch marker. Continue to knit all rounds until snood measures 13".

-At beginning of the first stitch marker add increases as follows:

\*k1, M1R, k to 2 stitches before the 2nd marker, M1L, k1, pass 2nd marker over to left needle, k1, M1R, knit to 2 stitches before the beginning of round marker, M1L, k1. Knit next round.\* Repeat from \* to \* 9(9, 7)more times until you reach 156(160, or 132) stitches on your needle.

-Work 1X1 rib for next 6 rounds.

-Bind off using Jenny's stretchy bind off. Use tapestry needle to weave in tails.

## Abbreviations:

k: knit

M1R: make one right (/ slant): with left needle tip, lift strand between needles from back to front. Knit the lifted loop through the front.

M1L: make one left(\ slant): with left needle tip, left strand between needles from front to back. Knit lifted loop through the back.

sts:stitch(s)
