PETE ORDOÑEZ APPOINTED TO FILL VACANT SEAT ON HURLEY TOWN COUNCIL

Eight candidates applied for the council seat left vacant when James Langley stepped down in September. After the candidates made 3-minute presentations about why they wanted to be on the council, Mayor Ed Stevens made his recommendations, with the Town Council ultimately approving Pete Ordoñez to fill the vacant seat.

During his presentation, Mr. Ordoñez spoke about his career in law enforcement and his time on Santa Clara's Board of Trustees. He highlighted experiences that he felt would benefit Hurley as well, including establishing a business park and installing a traffic light on Highway 180. He was sworn in during the meeting.

Mr. Ordoñez will serve on the Hurley Town Council through the end of 2025.
