Stage Two Fire Restrictions

Per the Mayor, Town Council and the Town Fire Chief has declared that drought conditions currently exist. By the Order of the Hurley Fire Chief, the following restrictions are in effect.

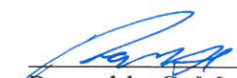
Prohibited Activities:

1. Charcoal briquettes and outdoor burning appliances: Use is prohibited on all public and private property.
2. UL/FM-approved gas pellet cooking devices: Permitted but must be attended by a competent adult at all times during use.
3. Fireworks (sale and use): **Prohibited**. All aerial devices, missile-type rockets, helicopters, spinners, stick-type rockets, and ground-based noise-producing devices. Possession or ignition within city limits is a citable offense.
4. Campfires and fire pits: Any open-flame fire, including those in designated pits or recreational fire features, is strictly prohibited.
5. Use of combustion-powered equipment (e.g., chainsaws, mowers, trimmers): Allowed only if the equipment is equipped with a properly installed, operational spark arrestor and used with extreme caution.
6. Welding and open-flame operations: Permitted only with a valid permit issued by the Fire Chief. All permits are automatically suspended during red flag warnings, high wind advisories, or fire weather watches as issued by the National Weather Service.

These Restrictions are effective starting June 15, 2026, and shall remain in effect until conditions improve and will only be lifted by the Town of Hurley Fire Chief.

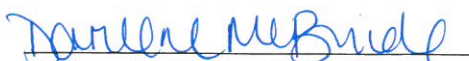
Anyone caught in violation of this order is subject to the following penalties: Fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days, or both.
