## **RULES FOR CREEKSIDE BOCCE BALL COURT – June 2022**

**USE OF THE CREEKSIDE OAKS BOCCE BALL COURT IS REGULATED BY THE FOLLOWING RULES APPROVED BY THE** CREEKSIDE OAKS BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

Anyone interested in playing Bocce should make a reservation in advance by using our online scheduling or emailing or calling CAROL DABB AT 941-1907.

The length of the reservation time depends upon the number of players. Up to eight players may play at one time. The allowed playing times are as follows:

2 Players: 60 minutes 4 players: 90 minutes 6 to 8 players: 120 minutes

After using your allotted reservation time, you may continue playing until another resident with or without a reservation wishes to play. Upon the arrival of other players, you must vacate the court. Residents with a reservation take precedence over residents with no advance reservation. A resident with no reservation, on the court playing a game, must yield the court to a resident with a reservation.

A homeowner must be present at all times in order for their guests to use the court. Court is available for use from 10:00 AM until dusk daily.

Flat, rubber soled shoes are to be worn on the court at all times. It is an expectation that anyone playing on the Bocce Ball court will treat the court and surrounding landscape with utmost care and respect. Food and drinks are allowed in the vicinity of the court, but not on the court itself.

If you need to blow debris off the court, a blower is available at the pool house. It must be returned when done using and plugged in for charging.

Players are asked to keep the noise to a reasonable level out of consideration for nearby residents.

The Bocce Balls are to be used to play the game ONLY. Please do not let children play with them.

When players have completed playing, all equipment should be cleaned and replaced in the designated storage area. The court and the surrounding area should be picked up and left in pristine condition.

A homeowner is allowed one reservation per day. Multiple reservations by a homeowner for the same day are subject to availability. Misuse of the court or the Bocce equipment will result in losing the privilege of playing on the Creekside court.

For security reasons the lock code will be changed as needed. The code will be given when

## reservations are made.

Residents will be held responsible for the actions and behaviors of their guests. Should any damage occur to the court or the equipment, that resident will be responsible for replacement and/or repair work needed. <u>Umbrellas</u> should be closed before leaving the court.

Two parking spaces are provided in the cul-de-sac adjacent to the Bocce Court, but all other cars must be parked on the right hand side of Bay Tree Lane. (No fire hydrants side)
