Tree & Landscape Update



It's that time of year when arborists from Imperial Tree will be on property to trim our trees. The elms and Crepe Myrtles are both on this fall's list, along with removing dead branches from some of our other trees.

At its October meeting, the Board approved the removal of certain grass areas to install drought-tolerant plants. As the cost of water continues to climb, we are planting drought tolerant plants from a list of approved plants provided to us by California Water Service, thereby securing a rebate for reducing our water usage. We hope to take advantage of this program as long as it lasts.

Borrowing from Reserves

- The Board approved the borrowing from reserves to pay insurance. The reserve account will be reimbursed within twelve months. This is a routine activity and a required disclosure.
