

## **CREEKSIDE OAKS GATE CODE AND CLOSURE INFORMATION**

Both **the El Monte AND the O'Keefe gates are closed 24 hours a day**. Entrance by non-residents will require using the podium call system with your response by phone, or one of the methods below. Please instruct your guests to dial from the keypad at the gate podiums, following instructions listed there. Once they call you, press '6' on your phone and the gate will open. Hang up your phone when you hear the tone that indicates the gate is opening. For residents only, there is a convenience gate code. **For owners/residents TO ENTER Creekside Oaks or to enter through the gates: #XXXX. TO EXIT WHEN ON FOOT OR WITHOUT YOUR REMOTE CONTROL: XXXX with no pound sign. PLEASE DO NOT GIVE THIS CODE TO FAMILY OR FRIENDS OR ANYONE. For the safety of all of us, please honor the use of the convenience code and keep it restricted to owner/resident use only. (Replace XXXX with the current code which is distributed in the Creeksider)**

Keycards are available for \$15. from Dave Apfelberg for your regular service providers whom you trust (caregivers, housekeepers, etc). You may request a special code be issued for a contractor who is going to perform work for you, or for special circumstances. Some of the codes will be temporary. If there is a misuse of the code, it will be deleted from the system. The gate software tracks use of codes providing us with a record of use. Please alert your delivery and service people with trucks to use the O'Keefe gate. Cars and small vehicles may use the El Monte gate. Regular delivery companies (FedEx, OnTrac, newspaper delivery, etc) all have codes. Emergency personnel, police, fire, etc. all have special codes.
