

Parking Rules Summary

For convenience a short summary of the parking rules is included below. The complete parking and traffic rules are contained in the Creekside Oaks Association Rules document found on the website: Creekside-oaks.com

Residents' Cars

Residents are encouraged to use their garage for parking. Resident's cars are ***required*** to be parked in the garage overnight. If an exception is needed, the resident should request a parking permit citing the reason. Please note, residents are subject to the same parking rules as outlined in the Parking and Traffic Rules Document.

Visitor Cars

The preferred parking location for visitors is at the upper pool, barn or by the O'Keefe gate. If no visitor parking is available or the visitor is unable to use the preferred location, parking in the resident driveway or nearby cul-de-sac is permissible. Short term visitors may park overnight in the resident's driveway for up to two (2) nights.

Parking Permits

Residents are encouraged to request permits for all overnight guests. Permits are mandatory for any guests parking for more than 2 nights.

Please include the vehicle license number, make, model and color of the vehicle. Also include the requestor name, house number and contact information along with the permit dates.

Note that guest cars can remain for a period not to exceed seven (7) days in any 90-day period unless authorized by a board-issued permit.

Caregiver Permits

The board will grant permits for caregivers for longer time periods. The maximum allowable period is six (6) months. Permits issued for caregiver vehicles include the requirement that the vehicle must always park in the designated parking areas only (day or night.)

Visitor Parking
