NAME(s): Bridge Creek

GENERAL LOCATION: Northwest side of Navajo Mountain

ACRES: 260 acres

TYPE OF BURNING: Wildfire

WILDFIRE DESCRIPTION: Aviation resources continue to work the Bridge Creek fire on the southwest flank with water drops. Other areas of fire are not as active but are still a concern. It is anticipated that fire activity will be active this afternoon, producing moderate to heavy smoke columns at times. Because the fire is located within steep and hazardous terrain, direct engagement with ground resources is still not an option. Today's plan is to continue utilizing aerial assets to limit fire spreading into Horse Canyon and threatening communication towers to the southeast. Values at risk include the communication towers and cultural aspects of mountain. There are no immediate threats to the community of Navajo Mountain, Utah currently.

SMOKE VISIBILITY/ DIRECTION: Smoke from the wildfires may be visible. There may be possible smoke inversion during the night and early morning.

REMARKS: ALL RESIDENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO AVOID THE WILDFIRE AREA AND ACCESS ROADS TO THE FIRE.
