Early Explorers

Each Friday from 10-10:45am , E3 Children's Museum offers exploration for preschoolers. This program, designed for children 2 to 5 years old, allows preschoolers to experience different science concepts and most adults will leave with ideas to try at home.

New tyrannosaurs, like the crested Guanlong from China, are changing and challenging our understanding of the evolution of these iconic, well-loved dinosaurs.
