### NAVAJO AREA INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE COVID-19 TESTING EVENT SCHEDULE

Window Rock, Arizona ---Navajo Area Indian Health Service health care facilities continue to offer COVID-19 testing.

According to the CDC, the following should get tested for COVID-19:

- People who have symptoms of COVID-19;
- Most people who have had close contact (within 6 feet for a total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period) with someone with confirmed COVID-19;
- People who have taken part in activities that put them at higher risk for COVID-19 because they cannot physically distance as needed to avoid exposure such as travel, attending large social or mass gatherings, or being in crowded or poorly-ventilated indoor settings.
- People who have been asked or referred to get tested by their health care provider.

Fully vaccinated people with no COVID-19 symptoms do not need to be tested following an exposure to someone with COVID-19. People who have tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 3 months and recovered do not need to get tested following an exposure as long as they do not develop new symptoms.

CDC also recommends that anyone with any signs or symptoms of COVID-19 get tested, regardless of vaccination status or prior infection. If you get tested because you have symptoms or were potentially exposed to the virus, you should stay away from others pending test results and follow the advice of your health care provider or a public health professional.

Prevent COVID-19 by taking the following steps: 1. Get a COVID-19 vaccine when it is available to you. 2. Wear a mask to protect yourself and others. 3. Stay at least 6 feet from others who don't live with you. 4. Avoid crowds and poorly ventilated spaces. 5. Wash your hands frequently.
