- Approval of March 11, 2025 agenda & November 19, 2024 minutes – by consensus.
- Note on CPB rules for Community Advisory Boards. KGLP finances okay.
- KGLP's next "Silent Campaign" planned for late April through July, 2025.
- Renewed talk by GOP and Trump administration to cut PBS and NPR funding.
- Zuni repeater status in question – looking for an engineer, first. Solar power? (Bill) Ray and Rachel both noted goal was expansion of EAS coverage. Carol noted that members of the Ramah area communities had requested better access to KGLP for some years (13 years, according to Rachel.)
- Gallup Public Radio board bylaws were recently updated to address prolonged absence, change campus head title to Chancellor, et. al. Noted need to review bylaws annually.
- GPR board in early stages of preparing for recruitment of new station manager. Ken and L.D. voiced need for CAB and community input on any candidates, and the desire for Rachel to be involved with the transition, whenever that is to begin.
- Bill reiterated desire for more local news, community participation.
- New transmitter and long-term backup power system working – more configuration needed for remote control, before relying on replacement Studio-Transmitter-Link.
- A heat pump was installed at KGLP's transmitter room in Summer, 2024. A second cooler will be replaced in the coming weeks with a backup heat pump.)
- Three GMCS student interns have been working at KGLP this semester.
