Traffic Report for December 5 – 16, 2022

NMDOT asks all motorists to obey all traffic signs, use caution, and watch for heavy equipment and construction personnel in all work zones. **PLEASE NOTE:** Conditions are subject to change without notice. Double fines for speeding in work zones in effect.

DURING BACKUPS, USE BOTH LANES AND TAKE TURNS MERGING. WATCH FOR SLOW MOVING OR STOPPED TRAFFIC. ALLOW EXTRA TIME AND EXPECT DELAYS.

Interstate:

I-40, mile marker 44, Coolidge Interchange

El Terrero Construction, LLC (Contractor) continues work on drainage structures. Eastbound I-40 is reduced to one lane and detoured onto the westbound median shoulder. Westbound has both lanes open. Speed reduced to 55 mph through the work zone. The contractor's work hours are 7am-5pm, weekdays. All traffic control will remain in place 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Peak travel times are Thursdays through Sundays from 2pm to 9pm. To avoid delays due to backups, please travel during off-peak times.

State Roadways:

NM 124, mile marker 7.7 – 16.7, west of Laguna Pueblo

AAI (Contractor) continues Mill and fill operations. NM 124 will be reduced to one lane during work hours. A pilot car and flaggers will be utilized through the work zone. Expect minor delays. The contractor's work hours are 7am-5pm, Monday – Friday.
