

Gallup Public Radio's Board of Directors meets on the second Monday of each month at 5:30 p.m., in UNMG Zollinger Library's front conference room.

Per requirements of the Communications Act of 1932, 47 U.S.C. §396, et. seq., as amended (Communications Act or Act), all persons shall be permitted to attend any meeting of the Board, or any such committee or body affiliated with KGLP, and no person shall be required, as a condition of attendance at any such meeting, to register such person's name or to provide any other information. The term "meeting" means the deliberations of at least a quorum of the total number of members of a governing or advisory body, or any committee thereof, required to take action on behalf of such body or committee where such deliberations determine or result in the joint conduct or disposition of the governing or advisory body's business, or the committee's business, as the case may be, but only to the extent that such deliberations relate to public broadcasting.

In order for a gathering of Gallup Public Radio's Board of Directors or committee members to conduct a meeting under the Act, the following are necessary:

1. the presence of a quorum; and
2. deliberations that determine or result in the joint conduct or disposition of business related to public broadcasting.

Deliberations do not require any formal action or vote. Any discussion of public broadcasting issues that may influence the opinions of members makes it a meeting.

While the Act requires stations to allow anyone to attend any Open Meeting (or any portion of a meeting that is open) without requiring the person to register, or provide his or her name or other information, such information may, at times, be necessary to ensure a safe meeting environment.

As the Corporation for Public Broadcasting has been dissolved, its governing power is no longer in force as it relates to public radio operations.
