Biggest problems in my district are water, waste water, housing and vacant homes

NGWSP due to delays and redesign, it is now too costly for our city. We are currently pushing for a \$76 Million cap for Gallup

Waste water- We recently fired our contractor and are now suing for its unfocused time.

I need Mark Dipoli in for this reason. He is the professional on these topics.

Housing - WE are currently working on work force housing for those whose income is too high for affordable housing and too low for market housing.

vacant homes- WE are working on streamlining city procedures to make vacant home cleanup quicker and easier to accomplish

4- Homelessness Fentanyl is the big problem here. A change in NM state law to mandate treatment for this drug is IMPORTANT!!!!
