

Just what is homeschooling?

- In the purest sense of the term, "Homeschooling" is the choice of a family to take sole responsibility for the education of their child(ren).
- In the early days of the homeschooling movement, parents assumed the total teaching responsibility - all the subjects, all the extra-curricular activities, etc.

- OPTION 1: ATTEND A CHURCH SCHOOL
- OPTION 2: ATTEND A PRIVATE SCHOOL
- OPTION 3: INSTRUCTION BY A PRIVATE TUTOR

Current Trends in Homeschool

Parents, under God, have the ultimate authority and control over their child and his/her education.



What do we offer the parents?

- Specific group meetings offer support to the new family, clarification of high school credits, etc.

Are there any requirements for the home educator?



This meeting provides HCA calendar events, co-op updates, club information, teaching resources, and much more.



Documentation of homeschooling for each enrolled student:

Although these regularly scheduled meetings are to document the academic records, it is a special time when team leader and individual family gather for encouragement and friendship. Academic records (attendance report, report card, reading and math reports, creative writing sample, and review of teacher lesson plans) are submitted to the assigned team leader.

Membership in Home School Legal Defense Association (HSLDA):

Our families are members of **HSLDA**, the Home School Legal Defense Association, a nonprofit advocacy organization established to defend and advance the constitutional right of parents to direct the education of their children and to protect family freedoms.

We offer beneficial tools for the home educator.

Grades 3, 5, 8 standardized achievement tests: The standardized tests are another helpful tool for the home teacher and are administered in the spring of the school year in a group setting.




ACT score for graduation: Individual colleges and universities have minimum standards for entrance. Because of this requirement, we set ACT standards for our graduates. However, if a student fails to meet this standard, we work with the family for other options for the high school diploma.




Our program is run with many volunteers.
