



APRIL THEME SACRIFICE

" I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." Galatians 2:20

Have you ever had a best friend you would do anything for. Imagine your best friend was taller than you. But that didn't matter to you. He or she liked you because you showed confidence and you are a Christian and always sharing the bible with him. They're closing the booth right after you. Your friend says, "bummer, I wish I could have been able to do the dunk tank." Kindly, you offer the last throw to him/her. You sacrificed your position for your friend.

Our bible memory verse is Galatians 2:20, "I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me.
