

Safeguarding Policy

(Reviewed on 1st of September 2024)



to protect children and young people who receive tuition from MRW Maths from harm.

This policy statement should be read alongside the tutoring agreement.

MRW Maths believes that:

- children and young people should never experience abuse of any kind
- we have a responsibility to promote the welfare of all children and young people, to keep them safe and to practise in a way that protects them.

MRW Maths recognise that:

- the welfare of children is paramount in all the work we do and in all the decisions we take
- working in partnership with children, young people, their parents, carers and other agencies is essential in promoting young people's welfare
- all children, regardless of age, disability, gender reassignment, race, religion or belief, sex, or sexual orientation have an equal right to protection from all types of harm or abuse
- some children are additionally vulnerable because of the impact of previous experiences, their level of dependency, communication needs or other issues
- extra safeguards may be needed to keep children who are additionally vulnerable safe from abuse.

MRW Maths will seek to keep children and young people safe by:

- valuing, listening to and respecting them
- adopting child protection and safeguarding best practice through this policy, procedures and tutoring agreement.
- developing and implementing an effective online safety practice and related procedures
- recording, storing and using information professionally and securely, in line with data protection legislation and guidance
- using our safeguarding and child protection procedures to share concerns and relevant information with agencies who need to know, and involving children, young people, parents, families and carers appropriately
- creating and maintaining an anti-bullying environment
- ensuring that we have effective complaints and whistleblowing measures in place
- ensuring that we provide a safe physical environment by applying health and safety measures in accordance with the law and regulatory guidance
- building a safeguarding culture where tutor, student and parents/carers treat each other with respect and are comfortable about sharing concerns.
