Easter is more than just one day. The feast of Easter is a season of fifty days, from Easter Eve to Pentecost. The Greek word Pentecost (fiftieth day) was used for the whole Paschal season. During this season there is no fasting, and the alleluias (praise the Lord) return. The white vestments are used, and the Paschal candle is lit at every service during the Easter Season. The Alleluia, Alleluia may be added to the dismissals during the great fifty days. St. Martin's uses Rite II, Prayer D during Eastertide.

Easter isn't just about eggs, jellybeans, and chocolate Easter bunnies. It's about the **new life we have in Christ**, in which we are set free to love, forgive and serve, and thereby find a sense of peace and joy in all that we do. By grabbing hold of the cross, we share in Jesus' victory over sin, death and all that would destroy us.

Let us follow the example of Jesus' first disciples, the Apostles. After Jesus walked through locked doors to appear to the eleven disciples and to show himself to Thomas, seven of the eleven disciples went back to their fishing business. They went back to their vocations or stations in life and took the witness of the resurrection with them. They lived in the joy of the resurrection of Jesus while carrying out the daily, ordinary labor and responsibilities given to them.

Now, we go forth from Easter Sunday and the celebration of the empty tomb free as God's forgiven children in Christ. Now we go forth empowered by God's Spirit living and active within us to live in the joy of the resurrection as "every day" witnesses.
