When this balance is disturbed, the effects may extend beyond the intestine and influence broader physiological function.

The microbiome is also relevant to the gut–brain axis. Communication between gut and brain occurs through neural, immune, endocrine, and metabolic pathways, meaning that the microbial environment of the gut may contribute to mood, cognitive clarity, stress resilience, and behavioural regulation.
