The T Totalers Chapter is excited to welcome you to Owatonna, MN, this July! We are planning a week full of beautiful driving routes, good food and fellowship, and interesting places to visit. Routes throughout the week will be along gently rolling terrain. The majority of the routes are paved, with a minimal number of gravel roads along the way.

The DoubleTree by Hilton in Owatonna is the host hotel and where many of our tour activities will take place. This brand new, full-service hotel includes an on-site restaurant and kids of all ages will enjoy the indoor water park! Trailer parking is located within a short walking distance.

The week's itinerary

Tour registration will be open on Saturday afternoon, Sunday, and for a short time on Monday morning.

Sunday: Get to Know the Area Tour

Explore the many historic sites in the river town of Owatonna in your Model T on a self-guided tour (directions will be included in your tour book). That evening the opening banquet will take place at the Four Seasons Centre.

Monday:

The car show and judging will be held in the morning at historic Mineral Springs Park. This wooded and shady setting will also be our lunch venue. You can have your tour photo taken for the *Model T Times* as you leave to embark on the afternoon tour to Zumbrota, famous for covered bridges. Monday evening we will host car games and an informal parts swap at the DoubleTree, so be

setting aside all those extra car parts that are taking up valuable space in your garage!

Tuesday:

We will retrace a portion of the route used by the James-Younger Gang in 1877. We will also be treated to a full re-enactment of the Northfield raid at the actual bank located in downtown Northfield. In the evening, we'll have an "enhanced" fashion show at the Village of Yesteryear featuring costumes from all eras — anything goes! And if you don't want to compete, you can still dress up — it's all for fun! Treats like popcorn, Minnesota-made soda, and, of course, ice cream will be available. The public will be invited to enjoy the fun costumes as well as the cars.

Wednesday:

We will travel west to Mankato to visit Minneopa State Park where you can see live buffalo up close, a waterfall, and other natural beauty. In the evening, the Youth Auction and awards ceremony will take place at the DoubleTree, along with a variety of youth activities.

Thursday:

We will visit Farmamerica, a vast complex with farm sites representing many eras — restored buildings are everywhere! A corn maze will be ready for you to explore, and live animals will be on the loose for you to enjoy. After lunch, we will visit Faribault Woolen Mills, one of only two remaining functional mills in the USA, and go on a full factory tour. In the evening, we will assemble on Main Street in Owatonna for a car show with a vast array of food trucks, street vendors, and live music. Kids will enjoy a bouncy house, face painting, and

other fun activities. This monthly event is always well attended by the public — in fact, they're hosting this one just for us — so be prepared to show off your car to a large crowd.

Friday:

We will travel east to the Kasson-Mantorville area to visit a historic Civil War recruitment center. Reenactors will be on hand with muskets and cannons, so expect a show. That evening we'll finish out the week with the closing banquet and awards at the Four Seasons Centre.

Youth Activities

Our Youth Activities coordinators are busily preparing for the tour, and we will share more details in a future issue. Remember that registration and youth activities for all youth age 17 and under are free, thanks to the Steve and Dianne Bumgarner Youth on Tour Fund.

Be sure to bring lawn chairs for events and meals where extra seating will be needed.


