All persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

The Sheriff's Office does not set bail or conditions of release and is not involved in the decision to modify or dismiss cases submitted to the courts. Further, the Sheriff's Office doesn't publish names of minors or victims of domestic or sexual assault.

Summary:

On 09/13/23 at approximately 10:00, Franklin County Sheriff's Deputies served a writ of possession on the occupants of 70 Kennison Drive Unit #19 in Enosburg, VT. While serving the writ, deputies identified one of the occupants as Brandon Bergeron. Bergeron was known to have two outstanding warrants: One was a "cite and release" warrant for two counts of cocaine sales (felony) and the other was for one count of aggravated assault with a deadly weapon (felony) and one count of cruelty to animals (misdemeanor) (\$200 bail). While searching Bergeron, he was found to be in possession of a controlled substance. Bergeron was transported to court on the latter warrant. Bergeron was also issued a citation to appear at Vermont District Court on October 9th at 10:00 am to answer the charge of possession of a controlled substance.

Also within the residence was Cassandra Sweet and Scott Burton. Investigation revealed that both Sweet and Burton were in possession of various drugs.

Sweet was issued a citation to appear at Vermont District Court on October 9th at 8:30 AM to answer the charges of impeding and possession of heroin, crack cocaine and stimulants.

Burton was issued a citation to appear at Vermont District Court on October 9th at 8:30 AM to answer the charge of possession of a controlled substance.
