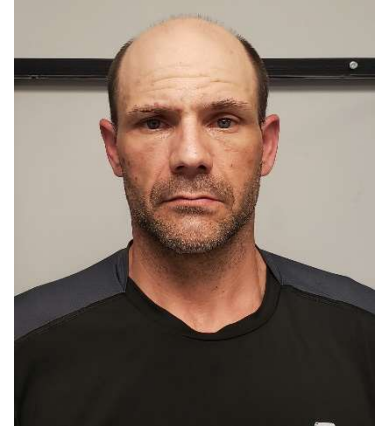

Arrest on Warrant for 2nd Degree Aggravated Domestic Assault



Location of Incident: St. Albans, Swanton, Highgate, Sheldon, Enosburg, Bakersfield, Cambridge, Underhill

Accused: Michael Marshall (03/21/75)

On 06/10/22 at approximately 9:15 AM, a Deputy with the Franklin County Sheriff's Office stopped Michael Marshall at the St. Albans Bay State Park, as it was known to the Deputy that Marshall had an outstanding warrant for 2nd Degree Aggravated Domestic Assault. As the Deputy was attempting to get Marshall to exit the car, Marshall sped off, dragging the Deputy with him (the Deputy received minor injuries).

Another Deputy with the Sheriff Office who was en route to assist, began a pursuit with Marshall. The pursuit lasted approximately one (1) hour and seven (7) minutes and went a distance of approximately 68 ½ miles and reached speeds at more than twice the posted speed limits. The pursuit went through St. Albans Town, Swanton, Highgate, Sheldon, Enosburg, Bakersfield, Cambridge and Underhill. At one point, Marshall is alleged to have attempted to ram one of the pursuing Deputies causing minor damage to a Sheriff's cruiser.

Marshall was taken into custody with the assistance of a Fish and Game Warden when his rented 2021 Hyundai Accent ran out of gas.

In addition to the above charges, Marshall was processed for DUI-D and was believed to be in possession of a controlled substance.

Marshall was lodged on the outstanding warrant and will be arraigned on the additional charges on Monday, June 13 at 1:00 PM.
