Summary:

Original Press Release

On the morning of Thursday December 28th at 0052 hours, Franklin County Sheriff's Deputies responded to an alarm at the Walgreens in Enosburg. Upon arrival deputies noticed broken glass in front of the business. Upon searching the business, they noticed a hammer on the floor that appeared to have been thrown through the window. It also appeared that the suspects broke the window and reached through it to steal several cartons of cigarettes. The two suspects then fled the area on foot into the village of Enosburg.

Update 01/12/24

On 12/29/23, Deputies with the Franklin County Sheriff's Office executed a search warrant at the residence of Steven Russell in Enosburg. The results of that search warrant yielded evidence tied to the burglary.

On 01/03/24, Russell was located and arrested by deputies. Russell has been charged with:

1. Burglary, Felony
2. Conspiracy, Felony
3. Accessory Before the Fact, Felony

Russell was flash cited to appear at Vermont District Court in St. Albans on 01/04/24.

Deputies also found probable cause to believe that Dyllon Rouleau was also involved in the burglary. Multiple attempts to locate Rouleau have been met with negative results. As a result, an arrest warrant has been sought on Rouleau.

The delay in producing this press release sooner was due to attempts to locate Rouleau.
