All persons are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

The Sheriff's Office does not set bail or conditions of release and is not involved in the decision to modify or dismiss cases submitted to the courts. Further, the Sheriff's Office doesn't publish names of minors or victims of domestic or sexual assault.

Summary:

On January 27, 2024, at approximately 0905 hours, a Franklin County Sheriff's Deputy received a report of a male stumbling on the side of the road near Route 104 and Highbridge Road in the Town of Fairfax, Vermont. A deputy located the male, later identified as Dilan Jiron (28), and in speaking with him it was discovered he was providing him a false name and date of birth. Jiron was found to have an outstanding warrant for violation of pre-trial conditions.

When Jiron was taken into custody for the warrant, deputies found \$115 in quarters in Jiron's pockets. Shortly after, the owner of Paul's Cow Wash contacted the Sheriff's Office to report his car wash had been broken into. Further investigation revealed that Jiron had broken into the car wash and stole quarters from the change machine.

Jiron was issued a flash citation to appear in Franklin County Superior Court-Criminal Division on January 29, 2024, at 1:00 PM for the crimes of burglary, possession of burglar's tools and false information to law enforcement. Jiron was lodged at Northwest State Correctional Facility in Saint Albans on a \$200 bail for the arrest warrant.
