

POINTS OF HOPE

Fentanyl is a deadly opioid that has been found in substances such as heroin, methamphetamine, ecstasy, molly, and other recreational drugs.

BE SAFE!

Test strips can tell you if there is fentanyl in the substance and help prevent overdose.

How to use a fentanyl test strip to help prevent overdose

Step 1 - Add water

Testing residue



Add 10 drops of sterile water to your cooker after you have drawn your shown and stir well.

Testing pills or powder



Add water to an empty bag with residue in it and mix well. If you have pills, break a piece of and stir it into water.

Step 2 - Test



Hold the blue end of your test strip and dip it into the water for 15 seconds. Be sure you only dip up to the wavy lines.

Step 3 - Wait



Wait two minutes until you can see lines show up in the middle.

What can I do after I get my test result?

1. I can have naloxone with me.
2. I can have someone with me who can call 911 and give me naloxone if I overdose.
3. I can go slow and use less.

Step 4 - Results



1 line - Positive for fentanyl



2 lines - Use caution

Read your test results. One line means that the substance has fentanyl in them.

No substance is 100% safe.
