- 4. Why should we award you a scholarship over others?
- 5. Provide a short budget of your expected costs for the season, not including the fees for participation. It should include any practice costs, stall/meet costs, travel costs, special clothing costs etc. Any costs that are related to OHSET that you (or your family) are not currently paying. For example, if you currently own a horse, you wouldn't include your feed costs, farrier, etc....but if you have to Board somewhere in order to make the OHSET season work, you should include Board, any stall or meet fees, if you have to stay in a hotel for meets or have RV costs, etc. Include how you expect to pay the extra costs; parents helping out, afterschool job, etc.
