A meet should not be the first time someone is driving or daubing or roping or even gaming. As coaches it’s our obligation to ensure that athletes are competent to compete in higher risk events.

 - Should be about standard poster board size (2’x3’)ish
 - For the state qualifiers it will go to state so it should be transportable and hangable ideally. They can go on the floor leaning but then risk getting kicked
 - Adhere pictures well- several last year required twice daily reassembly.
 - There will be a form link coming out for the senior booklet for the senior ceremony. Please disperse that to seniors once it’s sent out and follow up with them to make sure they complete it if they’d like to be included.
