

✂ How to Build a Sukkah (Sukkot Booth)

For Sukkot – Feast of Tabernacles

Can be adjusted for table top model

Step 1: Choose Your Spot

- Flat ground, backyard, deck, patio, or porch.
 - Make sure it's open enough to see the sky/stars through the roof covering.
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Step 2: Build the Frame

Option A – PVC Frame

- 4 long PVC pipes (for height)
- 4 short PVC pipes (for top edges)
- Corner connectors
- Drape sheets, tarps, or bamboo mats for walls

Option B – Wood/Pallet Frame

- 4 upright wooden posts or pallets
- Secure with screws, nails, or rope
- Attach sheets, fabric, or lattice for walls

Option C – Pop-Up Canopy

- Use a tent frame or canopy
 - Remove solid roof
 - Replace with natural coverings (branches, bamboo, etc.)
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Step 3: Cover the Roof (Sechach)

The roof should provide shade but let you see the stars ✨

- Palm branches

- Bamboo sticks or garden fencing rolls
 - Corn stalks
 - Evergreen branches
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Step 4: Decorate Your Sukkah

- Hang fruit & vegetables (apples, gourds, citrus)
 - Paper chains & lanterns
 - Bible verses on cardstock
 - String lights or lanterns
 - Prayer notes hung on ribbons
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Step 5: Dwell & Rejoice

- Place table and chairs inside
- Eat your meals in the sukkah
- Pray, sing, and give thanks for God's provision
- Invite friends or family to share fellowship
