Survival Kit Suggestions

At a minimum, you should have the basic supplies listed below.

- 1. Water: one gallon per person, per day (3-day supply for evacuation, 2-week supply for home)
- 2. Food: non-perishable, easy-to-prepare items (3-day supply for evacuation, 2-week supply for home)
- 3. Flashlight
- 4. Battery-powered or hand-crank radio (NOAA Weather Radio, if possible)
- 5. Extra batteries
- 6. First aid kit Trauma Kit
- 7. Medications (7-day supply) and medical items
- 8. Multi-purpose tool
- 9. Sanitation and personal hygiene items
- 10. Copies of personal documents (medication list and pertinent medical information, proof of address, deed/lease to home, passports, birth certificates, insurance policies)
- 11. Cell phone with chargers
- 12. Family and emergency contact information
- 13. Extra cash
- 14. Emergency blanket
- 15. Map(s) of the area

After you gather those basic supplies for your kit, add unique things each member of your family may need, such as:

- Medical supplies (hearing aids with extra batteries, glasses, contact lenses, syringes, etc)
- Baby supplies (bottles, formula, baby food, diapers)
- Games and activities for children
- Pet supplies (collar, leash, ID, food, carrier, bowl)
- Two-way radios
- Extra set of car keys and house keys
- Manual can opener

Depending on the types of disasters that are common where you live, also consider adding

these things to your kit:

- Whistle
- N95 or surgical masks
- Matches
- Rain gear
- Towels
- Work gloves
- Tools/supplies for securing your home
- Extra clothing, hat and sturdy shoes
- Plastic sheeting
- Duct tape
- Scissors
- Household liquid bleach
- Entertainment items
- Blankets or sleeping bags
- AX (Safer than a Machete and the butt can double as a hammer)
- Wire and Rope
- Sewing Kit
- Cloth Bandana's

Miscellaneous and Self Defense

- Small Note Pad/Pencils
- Sunglasses, N95 Mask, Latex Free Gloves, Resealable Bags, Clear Contractor Trash Bags, Parachute Cord 550 (50')
- Be well equipped to defend yourselves and hunt wild game if needed

Lighting

- LED Headlamp
- Mini LED Keychain
- Light Glowstick
- Mini LED Light
- Tea Candles
- Solar Lantern / Charger
- Batteries
- Flairs

Communications

A good way to recall the following is "P.A.C.E." — Primary, Alternate, Contingency, Emergency. They are as follows:

- Primary Cell Phone
- Alternate WIFI/Tablet
- Contingency Ham Radio w/ License
- Emergency Crank Power Charger with Signal Lights

HEAT SOURCE

Having several means for starting a fire is also essential when bugging out. We recommend the following basics to be included in every bug out bag. The reason being, a survivalist and firearms expert friend of ours shared this piece of wisdom which has stuck with us ever since –

We recommend having at least 3 different means of starting a fire on your bug out bag list of items to pack.

- Lighter
- Ferrocerium Rod
- Tinder (Qty 3)
- Waterproof Storage

HYGIENE

We've found that various aspects of personal hygiene are often overlooked when compiling a bug out bag list of essentials. But the implications of forgoing any of these for an extended period of time might lead to bacterial infections and a rapid deterioration in health. When bugging out, you need to be at the top of your game, so be sure to pack these items.

- Wet Napkins
- Hand Sanitizer
- All-Purpose Camp Soap
- Hygiene/Signal Mirror
- Small Pack Towels
- Travel Toilet Paper (Qty 2)
- Travel Size Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Other Personal Hygiene Necessities

Travel Aids

Depending on the situation you find yourself in, these items might prove quite useful. **Don't leave home without carefully thinking these through first**. Some question the effective use of quarters and precious metals in a modern bug out scenario. I'll leave it up to you to decide whether it is worth the few extra ounces to carry just in case.

- \$500 Minimum in Small Bills
- Quarters (Qty 8)
- Gold / Silver Bullion Coins
- Local Area Map
- Compass
- Small Note Pad / Pencil
- Cotton Bandanas
