

Day of the Lord = Yom Adonai = Yohm Ah-doh-NYE

Yom means:

a literal 24-hour day, a specific time period, or a significant event or season of judgment.

YHWH is traditionally pronounced as **Adonai** or **Yahweh = LORD**

Altogether, it means:

a specific time when God directly intervenes in human history—a day of judgment, justice, and accountability, and a day of deliverance for all those who belong to Him

Omer

Sound out: *OH-mer*

Meaning: A sheaf or measure of grain.

The Omer is counted from Firstfruits to Pentecost.

Pentecost

Sound out: *Sha-voo-OHT*

Meaning: Weeks

Shavuot is the Feast of Weeks, celebrated 50 days after Firstfruits.
