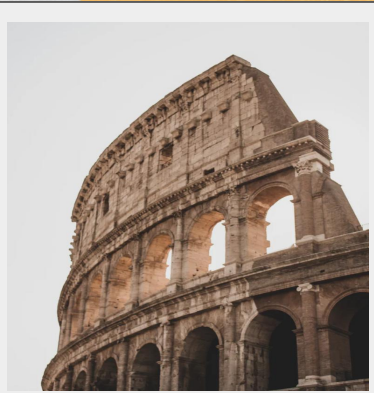

= to turn back, repent

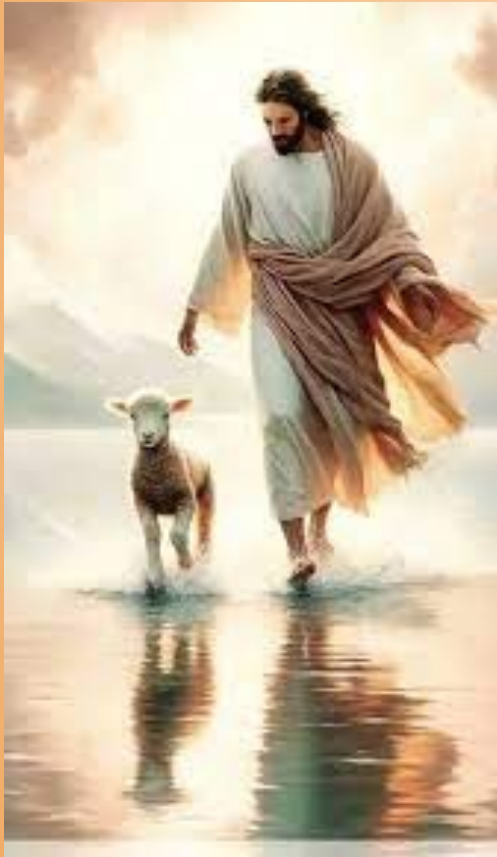
Greek → "*metanoia*"

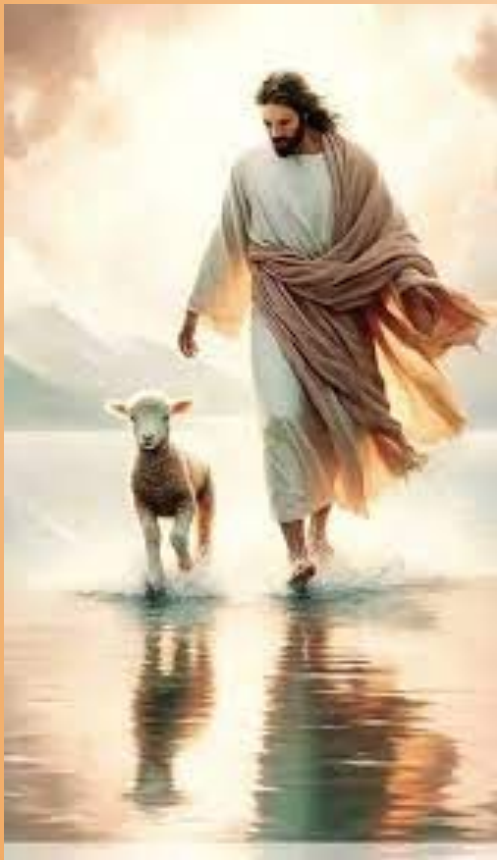

REPENTENCE



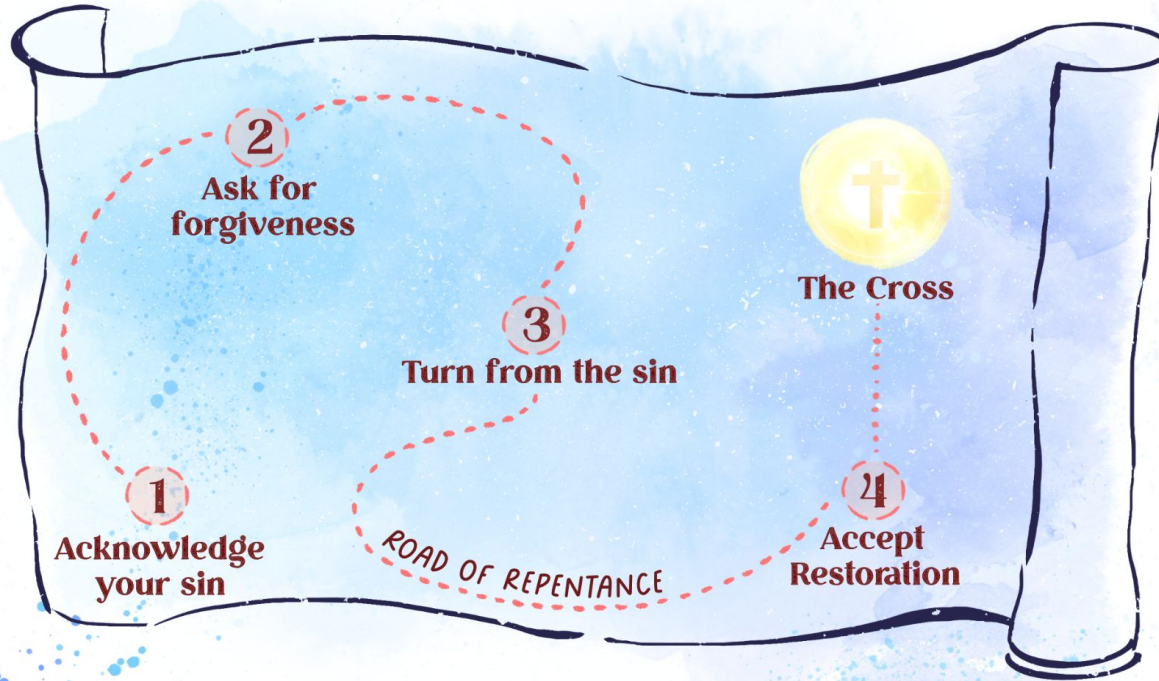
It's a result of brokenness

- It's lasting change brought about out of Brokenness and leads us to Repentance
- It's a conviction on how we treat Jesus
- God's people, broken about their sinfulness.

Turn around from your sin

- Repentance is more than remorse, it's a **mental decision to stop and actually change**
- Real acknowledgement of what we did
- Admitting spiritual and emotional wrong to our God
- Being Truthful and accepting the results of your sin

Have You Acknowledge Your Sin?



You have to admit you have sinned. Do not try to cover it up, or hide the truth from God.

- The weight of the Sin is too heavy, it hangs over you, until you can no handle another minute of it.
- So you tell GOD, what He already knew, that you sinned. You **agree with God that what you did was wrong**
- You **CONFESS** who your sin is **AGAINST. ITS AGAINST GOD**

When you know you **SINNED** against God, You **NEED** to acknowledge your Sin

Map to Forgiveness



Ask for Forgiveness

You've acknowledged that you sinned against God, now you're going to have to ask for God Forgiveness.

- Ask God to clean, purify, purge, make you as clean as snow, and help you to Separate from the sin.
- Cry out for Forgiveness
- Ask God with a pure heart to Forgive you of that Sin.

(Ephesians 1:7, Colossians 1:14)

Turn FROM the Sin, that means **CHANGE**.

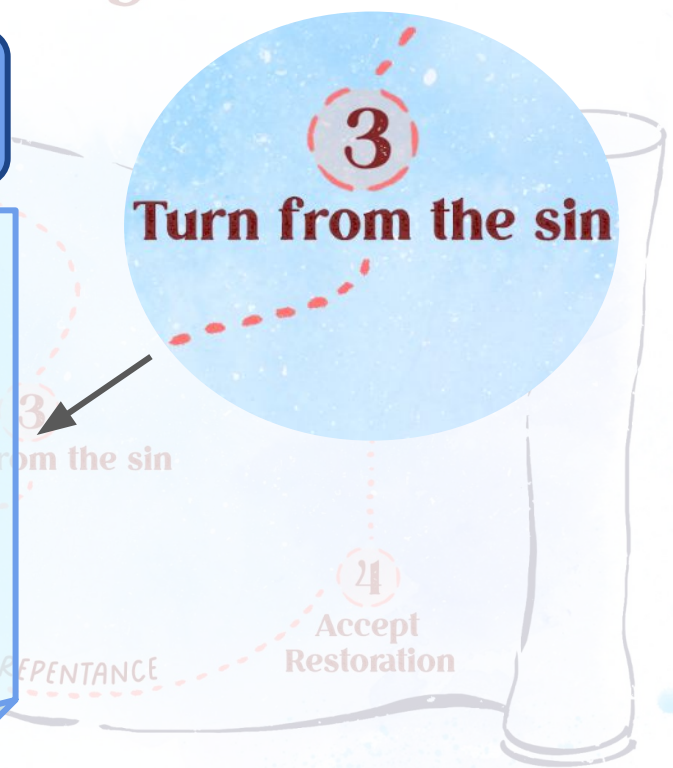
- That means STOP

THE CROSS

What was done on the Cross removes the sin and throws it in the sea of forgetfulness (Micah 7:19)

34 But Jesus said, "Peter, let me tell you something. Before the rooster crows tomorrow morning, you will deny three times that you even know me."

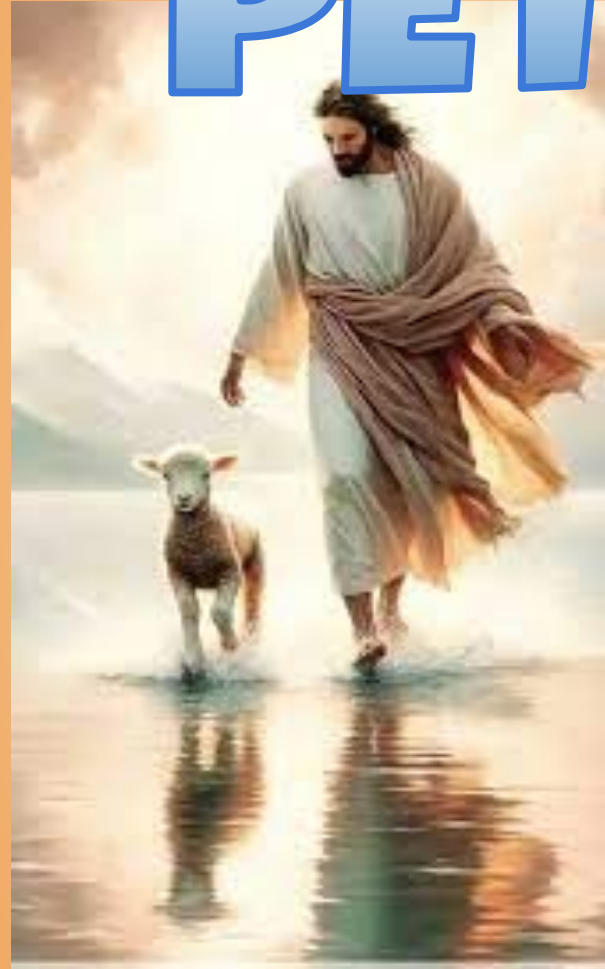
PETERS REGRET

LUKE 22: 61-62

61 At that moment the Lord turned and looked at Peter. Suddenly, the Lord's words flashed through Peter's mind: "Before the rooster crows tomorrow morning, you will deny three times that you even know me." 62 And Peter left the courtyard, weeping bitterly.



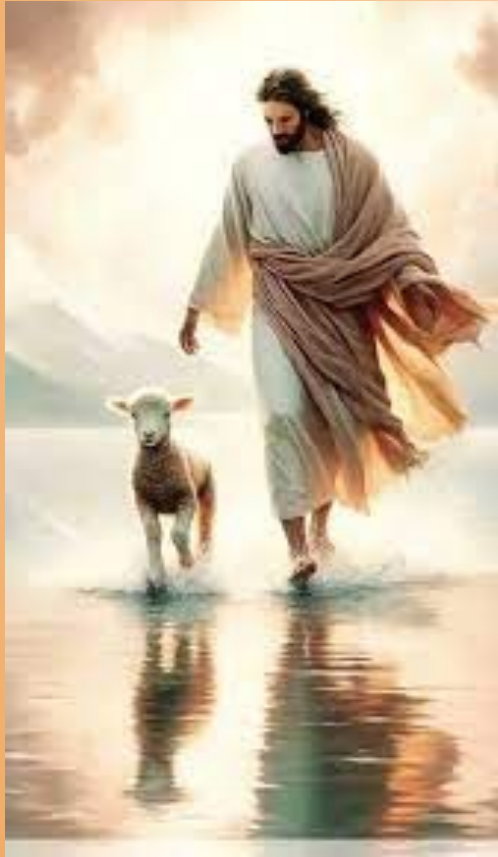
PETER WEPT



Jesus also showed compassion to Peter.

- He prayed for Peter (Luke 22:32 – But I have prayed for you that your faith may not fail.)
- Just at the moment when Peter denied Jesus for the third time, Jesus turned and looked at him. (Luke 22:61-62 And the Lord turned and looked at Peter. And Peter remembered the saying of the Lord, how he had said to him, “Before the rooster crows today, you will deny me three times.” And he went out and wept bitterly.) That look must have stricken Peter. Jesus knew. And Peter knew that Jesus knew. In Jesus’ hour of need, Peter failed to back up his boastful words and denied his Savior, his Messiah, his friend.

PSALMS 51



True Repentance from King David

Let's dissect and discuss Davids realization of his sin and the cost to his relationship with God.

The Effects of his Sin broke his heart, the truth of his Confession and Repentance in Psalms 51, show us the depth of Respect, Honour and Love for Father God

David's Repentance demonstrates how to truly Repent, not taking another breathe, until he was right with God Amen

PSALMS 51

1 Have mercy on me, O God, because of your unfailing love. Because of your great compassion, blot out the stain of my sins.

2 Wash me clean from my guilt. Purify me from my sin.

3 For I recognize my rebellion, it haunts me day and night.

4 Against you, and you alone, have I sinned;

I have done what is evil in your sight.

You will be proved right in what you say,

and your judgment against me is just.

5 For I was born a sinner—

yes, from the moment my mother conceived me.

6 But you desire honesty from the womb,

teaching me wisdom even there.

7 Purify me from my sins, [and I will be clean;

wash me, and I will be whiter than snow.

8 Oh, give me back my joy again; you have broken me—

now let me rejoice.

9 Don't keep looking at my sins. Remove the stain of my guilt.

10 Create in me a clean heart, O God.

Renew a loyal spirit within me.

11 Do not banish me from your presence,
and don't take your Holy Spirit[d] from me.

12 Restore to me the joy of your salvation,
and make me willing to obey you.

13 Then I will teach your ways to rebels, and they will return to you.

14 Forgive me for shedding blood, O God who saves; then I will joyfully sing of your forgiveness.

15 Unseal my lips, O Lord, that my mouth may praise you.

16 You do not desire a sacrifice, or I would offer one. You do not want a burnt offering.

17 The sacrifice you desire is a broken spirit.

You will not reject a broken and repentant heart, O God.

18 Look with favor on Zion and help her;
rebuild the walls of Jerusalem.

19 Then you will be pleased with sacrifices offered in the right spirit—

with burnt offerings and whole burnt offerings.

Then bulls will again be sacrificed on your altar.
