*Revelation was written in Greek, but these Hebrew words help us understand its biblical themes.*

Hebrew Word	Pronunciation	Meaning	Connection
<b>Malkhut</b>	mahl-KHOOT	Kingdom; reign; royal rule	Christ reigns for 1,000 years — Revelation 20:4, 6
<b>Mishpat</b>	meesh-PAHT	Judgment; justice; a righteous decision	The Great White Throne Judgment — Revelation 20:11–12
<b>Sefer HaChayim</b>	SEH-fer hah-khah- YEEM	Book of Life	Names written in the Book of Life — Revelation 20:12, 15
<b>Satan</b>	sah-TAHN	Adversary; accuser	Satan is bound, released, and finally judged — Revelation 20:2, 10
<b>Shakan</b>	shah-KAHN	To dwell; to live among	God will dwell with His people — Revelation 21:3
<b>Shamayim Chadashim</b>	shah-MAH-yim khah-dah-SHEEM	New heavens	God makes a new heaven — Revelation 21:1
<b>Eretz Chadashah</b>	EH-rets khah-dah- SHAH	New earth	God creates a new earth — Revelation 21:1
<b>Mavet</b>	MAH-vet	Death	Death will be no more — Revelation 21:4
