

CHRISTIAN WITNESSING IN SAUDI ARABIA (WIKIPEDIA)

Proclaiming or sharing the Christian faith is strictly illegal in Saudi Arabia. The government prohibits non-Islamic proselytizing, blasphemy, and public expressions of any non-Muslim religion. Engaging in evangelism can lead to arrest, imprisonment, and deportation, while citizens who leave Islam face extreme social and legal consequences.

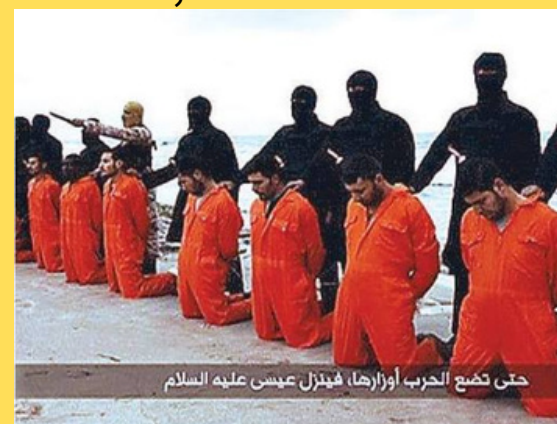
