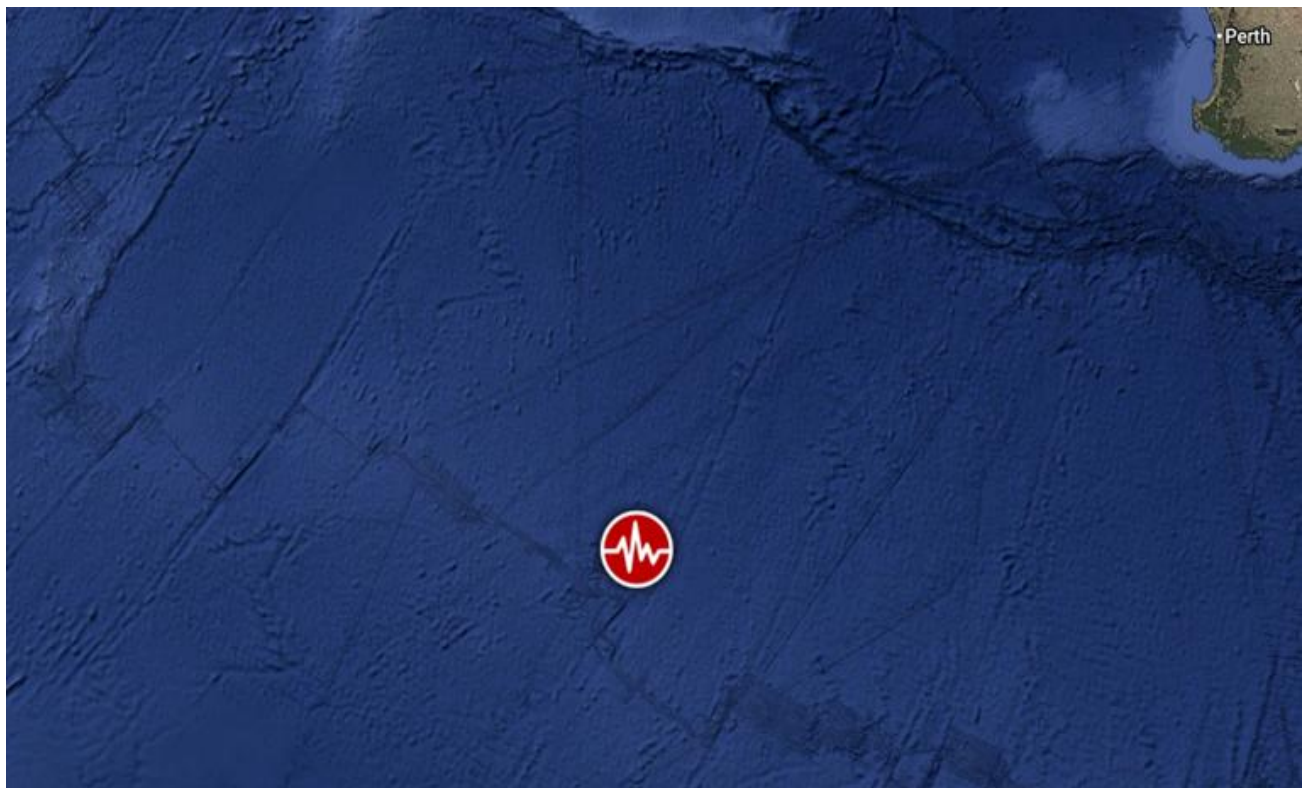
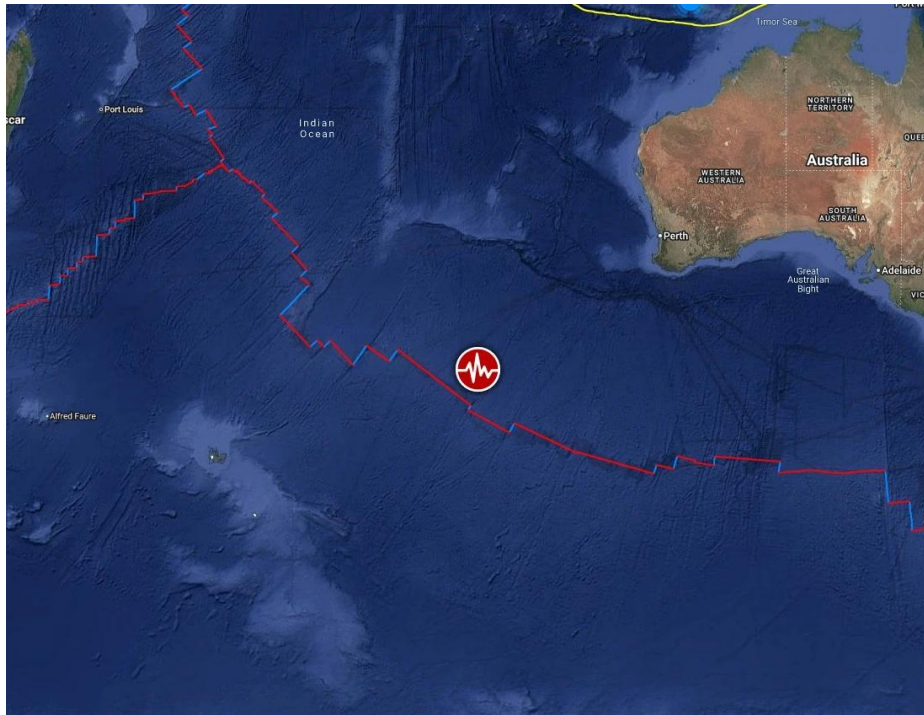


Shallow M6.0 earthquake hits southeast Indian Ridge

November 1, 2025

A shallow earthquake registered by the USGS as M6.0 struck southeast Indian Ridge at 20:53 UTC on October 31, 2025. The agency is reporting a depth of 10 km (6.2 miles). No tsunami warning was





The epicenter was located 1 964 km (1 220 miles) WSW of Augusta (population 1 362) and 2 027 km (1 259 miles) WSW of Busselton (population 21 898), Australia.

There is no tsunami threat from this earthquake.

The USGS issued a Green alert for shaking-related fatalities and economic losses. There is a low likelihood of casualties and damage.

There are likely to be no affected structures in this region.
