HOW ENTERTAINMENT CAN HARDEN HEARTS AND DARKEN TRUTH

The pages of history speak loudly. The pages of today's culture may be speaking even louder.

A recent in-depth editorial examination reveals how the Roman Empire used entertainment not just for enjoyment, but as a tool to control the masses, distract from injustice, and desensitize people to violence. The same spirit is rising in our world today.

THE ROMAN PATTERN

In the days of the Roman Empire, arenas were filled with blood sport, gladiator fights, animal hunts, and public executions. These events were not random—they were carefully orchestrated. Free admission, lavish spectacles, and constant celebration kept the people entertained and the truth buried. As one historian notes, "The population was fed and entertained while real issues—corruption, poverty, and injustice—were ignored."

DRAKING PUBLIC FUNDS
